118 -119	Guiderius son of Cymbeline, Arviragus son of Cymbeline	43 AD. Claudius Emperor of Rome comes to Britain. St Peter is in Antioch then Rome, St Mark is in Egypt	
120	Marius, Coilus	Vespasian sent to Britain by Claudius	
121	Lucius who dies in 156 AD	175 - 89 AD. Pope Eleutherus sends Faganus and Duvianus to Britain	

122 -123	Geta born to Severus (a Roman commander) and a Roman mother, Bassianus born to Severus (a Roman commander) and a British mother. Carausius "born of humble parentage" usurped the throne but not conted as a king	208-11 AD. Severus comes to ritain, builds his wall and diesin York	
124	Asclepiodotus Duke of Cornwal	303 AD onwards. Persecution of Christians by Diocletian	
125 -126	Coel. Killed Ascelepidotus. Constantius, Roman commander. Married Coel's daughter Helen	296-306 AD. Constantius I is in Britain. Dies in York	Possibly the "Old King Cole" of the nursery rhyme.
127 - 133	Constantine I. Son of Constantius. Octavius. Duke of the Gewessei. Trahern, brother of Coel. Maximianus, a Roman senator, son of loelenius a brother of king Coel. Built a huge empire in Gaul and Germany. Gracianus, a freedman sent by Maximianus to help the Britons against the Picts and the Huns. Constantine II, brother of Aldroenus, king of Brittany. Constans, son of Constantine II.	306-37AD. Constantine the Great is Emperor	
134 -138	Vortigern. leader of the Gewissei. Instigates assassination of Constans and crowns himself king. In his reign Merlin is found as a boy.Vortimer son of Vortigern. Aurelius Ambrosius, second son of Constantine II. Utherpendragon, third son of Constantine II	450-55AD. Hengist and Horsa come to Britain	Merlin is discovered as a boy during the reign of Vortigern. Produces prophecies concerning the future of Britain. Beginning of the Anglo-Saxon invasion
139	Arthur son of Utherpendragon	542 AD	Arthur, wounded in the battle of Camblam, hands the throne to Constantine III in 542 AD

141 - 150	Aurelius Conanus, nephew of Constantine. Vortiporius, Malgo, Keredic, Three unnamed tyrants, Cadvan, Cadwallo son of Cadvan, Cadwallader son of Cadwallo.	597 AD. Augustine, sent by Pope Gregory I, comes to Britain.	Cadwallader, the last British King. Died in 689 AD
