49	Alfred the Great. King of the Anglo-Saxons	849 - 899	Alfred was a son of Æthelwulf/Ethelwulf, king of Wessex, and his wife Osburh
50	Edward the Elder. King of the Anglo-Saxons.	877 - 924	Edward's parents, Alfred and Ealhswith
51	Edmund I of England	921 - 946	He was the elder son of King Edward the Elder and his third wife, Queen Eadgifu.
52	Edgar the Peaceful. King of the English	943 - 975	Edgar was the son of Edmund I and Ælfgifu of Shaftesbury.
53	Æthelred II. Æthelred the Unready. King of the English	968-1016	Æthelred was the son of King Edgar the Peaceful and Queen Ælfhryth.
54	Edmund II. Edmund Ironside. King of the English	990 - 1016	He was the son of King Æthelred the Unready and his first wife, Ælfgifu of York
55	Edward the Exile	1016 - 1057	Also called Edward Ætheling. He was the son of King Edmund Ironside and of Ealdgyth. He spent most of his life in exile in the Kingdom of Hungary following the defeat of his father by Cnut the Great.
56	Margaret of Wessex. Also known as Saint Margaret of Scotland	1045 - 1093	Margaret was the daughter of the English prince Edward the Exile and his wife Agatha. Married Malcolm III of Scotland
57	Matilda of Scotland	1080 - 1118	Born in 1080, in Dunfermline, Scotland, her parents were King Malcolm III and Margaret of Wessex.. Married Henry I of England.
58	Empress Matilda of Scotland	1102 - 1167	Matilda was born to Henry I, King of England and Duke of Normandy, and his first wife, Matilda of Scotland,
59	Henry II. King of England	1133 - 1189	Henry was born in Normandy at Le Mans on 5 March 1133, the eldest child of the Empress Matilda and her second husband, Geoffrey Plantagenet, Count of Anjou.
60	John. King of England	1166 - 1216	John was the youngest of the four surviving sons of King Henry II of England and Duchess Eleanor of Aquitaine.
61	Henry III of England	1207 - 1272	Henry was born in Winchester Castle on 1 October 1207. He was the eldest son of King John and Isabella of Angoulême
62	Edward I of England. Edward Longshanks.	1239 -1307	Edward was born at the Palace of Westminster on the night of 17–18 June 1239, to King Henry III and Eleanor of Provence.
63	Edward II of England	1284 - 1372	Edward II was the fourth son[1] of Edward I, King of England, Lord of Ireland, and ruler of Gascony in south-western France (which he held as the feudal vassal of the king of France),[2] and Eleanor, Countess of Ponthieu in northern France.
64	Edward III of England	1284 - 1372	Fayher was Edward II. Mother was Isabella of France
65	Lionel of Antwerp	1338 -1368	Lionel of Antwerp, Duke of Clarence, was the third son, but the second son to survive infancy, of the English king Edward III and Philippa of Hainault.
66	Philippa Plantagenet, 5th Countess of Ulster	1355 -1382	She was born at Eltham Palace in Kent on 16 August 1355, the only child of Lionel of Antwerp, 1st Duke of Clarence, and Elizabeth de Burgh, 4th Countess of Ulster.
67	Roger Mortimer, 4th Earl of March	1374 -1398	Roger Mortimer was born 11 April 1374 at Usk in Monmouthshire. He was the eldest son of Edmund Mortimer, 3rd Earl of March, by his wife Philippa of Clarence, who was the daughter of Lionel of Antwerp, 1st Duke of Clarence, and granddaughter of King Edward III
68	Anne de Mortimer	1390 - 1411	Born on 27 December 1388, Anne Mortimer was the eldest of the four children of Roger Mortimer, 4th Earl of March (1374–1398), and Eleanor Holland (1370–1405).
69	Richard of York, 3rd Duke of York. Also known as Richard Plantagenet	1411 - 1460	Richard of York was born on 22 September 1411, the son of Richard, Earl of Cambridge (1385–1415), and his wife Anne Mortimer (1388–1411)

70	Edward IV of England	1442 -1483	Edward was born on 28 April 1442 at Rouen in Normandy, eldest surviving son of Richard, 3rd Duke of York, and Cecily Neville.
71	Elizabeth of York	1466 -1503	Elizabeth of York was born at the Palace of Westminster as the eldest child of King Edward IV and his wife, Elizabeth Woodville
72	Margaret Tudor	1489 - 1541	She was the eldest daughter and second child of King Henry VII of England and Elizabeth of York, and the sister of King Henry VIII of England.
73	James V of Scotland	1512 - 1542	James was the son of King James IV and Margaret Tudor,
74	Mary I of Scotland. Mary Queen of Scots.	1542 - 1587	Mary was born on 8 December 1542 at Linlithgow Palace, Scotland, to King James V and his French second wife, Mary of Guise
75	James VI of Scotland and I of England	1566 -1625	James was the only son of Mary, Queen of Scots, and her second husband, Henry Stuart, Lord Darnley.
76	Elizabeth Stuart Queen of Bohemia	1596 - 1662	Elizabeth was the second and eldest daughter of James VI and I, King of Scotland, England and Ireland, and his wife, Anne of Denmark.
77	Sophia of Hanover	1613 - 1714	The twelfth child of Frederick V of the Palatinate and Elizabeth Stuart
78	George I of Great Britain	1660 - 1727	He was the eldest son of Ernest Augustus, Duke of Brunswick-Luneburg, and his wife, Sophia of the Palatinate.
79	George II of Great Britain	1683 - 1760	Son of George I and Sophia Dorothea of Celle
80	Frederick Prince of Wales	1707 -1751	Frederick, Prince of Wales, KG (Frederick Louis, German: Friedrich Ludwig; 31 January 1707 – 31 March 1751), was heir apparent to the British throne from 1727 until his death from a lung injury at the age of 44. He was the eldest but estranged son of King George II and Caroline of Ansbach, and the father of King George III.
81	George III	1738 - 1820	He was a grandson of King George II, and the eldest son of Frederick, Prince of Wales, and Augusta of Saxe-Gotha.
82	Prince Edward, Duke of Kent and Strathearn	1767 - 1820	Prince Edward was born on 2 November 1767.[7] His parents were the reigning British monarch, George III, and Charlotte of Mecklenburg-Strelitz.
83	Queen Victoria of the United Kingdom	1819 - 1901	Victoria's father was Prince Edward, Duke of Kent and Strathearn, the fourth son of the reigning King of the United Kingdom, George III.. Her mother was Princess Victoria of Saxe-Coburg-Saalfeld.
84	Edward VII of the United Kingdom	1841 - 1910	He was the eldest son and second child of Queen Victoria and her husband, Prince Albert of Saxe-Coburg and Gotha.
85	George V of the United Kingdom	1865 - 1936	George was born on 3 June 1865, in Marlborough House, London. He was the second son of Albert Edward, Prince of Wales, and Alexandra, Princess of Wales.
86	George VI of the United Kingdom	1895 - 1952	His father was Prince George, Duke of York (later King George V), the second and eldest surviving son of the Prince and Princess of Wales (later King Edward VII and Queen Alexandra). His mother, the Duchess of York (later Queen Mary).
87	Elizabeth II of the United Kingdom	1926 - 1922	Her father, the Duke of York (later King George VI), was the second son of the King. Her mother, the Duchess of York (later Queen Elizabeth The Queen Mother), was the youngest daughter of Scottish aristocrat Claude Bowes-Lyon, 14th Earl of Strathmore and Kinghorne.
88	King Charles III	1948 -	He was the first child of Princess Elizabeth, Duchess of Edinburgh (later Queen Elizabeth II), and Philip, Duke of Edinburgh.
